Pink, the longest-serving Artistic Director in the history of Milwaukee Ballet, has earned widespread acclaim for his theatrical interpretations of iconic works such as *Romeo & Juliet*, *The Sleeping Beauty*, and *Swan Lake*. His production of *Dracula* stays true to Stoker's novel while introducing new dramatic elements, culminating in a gripping final showdown with a hoard of the undead in a cathedral crypt.

Michael Pink's accolades include the Wisconsin Dance Council's Choreography/Performance Award and the Milwaukee Press Club's Headliner Award for his outstanding contributions to the arts. His vision continues to elevate the international dance scene by merging classical storytelling with innovative choreography.

The production will feature set design by the Tony Award-winning Lez Brotherston, whose haunting, immersive designs perfectly capture Dracula's chilling world.
