

# Gingers

## CLOTHING:

- Girls: Nude camisole-changing leotard.
- Boys: White tank top, black bike shorts.
- Both: No tights, unless the child prefers them.
- Both: Painted Shoes, purchase pink leather ballet shoes and turn them into ballet for dying.

## HAIR:

- High bun.
- 3" from the forehead (right on top of the head).
- No bangs.

## COSTUME:

- Put on unitard, zipper in the back and put on painted shoes.
- Unsnap straps in the front, put on dress/shorts.
- Snap straps, be sure they are crisscrossed in the back.
- Put on frosting cuffs so the sheer fabric goes down over the hand.
- For the choker, the ruffle needs to face outward. Twist on both sides right next to the button and then snap at the back.
- Put the hat on. The strap goes IN FRONT of the ears. If that is covering the eyes add some foam inside the top of the hat (foam is in the hat bin). If you add too much foam they will fall off. Have the girls practice a cartwheel to ensure the hat stays on.

## MAKEUP

- Girls
  - Foundation (only if needed).
  - Soft pink blush to cheeks.
  - A light coat of neutral pink lipstick.
  - A light coat of black mascara (only if needed for fair lashes and only if tolerated by young cast members).
- Boys
  - Neutral blush to cheeks.
  - A light coat of mascara to fair lashes (only if tolerated by young cast members).
