Before You Leave Home

Entering the Auditorium


- You will enter through the green auditorium doors.
- A volunteer can help you find a seat.
- You can sit anywhere you feel comfortable.
- You may have to wait a little while until the show begins.
- When the show starts, the lights will be a little dim, but not dark like a regular show.



During the Performance

- You can sit, stand, wiggle, or move around.
- You are allowed to whisper and make noise and you can clap and cheer for the dancers. 
- It's okay to use fidgets, toys, stimming tools, or electronic devices.
- If it gets too loud, you can wear headphones, ear plugs, or step into the Calm Space. 
- Everyone can enter and leave the theater anytime during the show — no need to stay seated the whole time.

After the Show

- When the performance is over, the dancers will come back on stage for a curtain call. This is a chance to cheer and clap for your favorite characters! This will be the loudest part of the day. 
- You will leave the same way you came in.
- It's okay to feel tired or excited or anything in between - talking about your favorite parts can help!
