## SACRAMENTO BALLET ELEVATES 2022/23 SEASON WITH ICONS, PARAGONS & RISING STAR-ARTISTS

Classical, Neo Classical & Modern, Vivacious Technical Dance Challenges Take Center Stage

**WHAT:** (September 30, 2022 - May 21, 2023) Sacramento Ballet has unveiled its enticing 2022/23 season schedule which celebrates the return of Tchaikovsky's classic *Swan Lake* & the beloved holiday favorite *Nutcracker* as well as George Balanchine & Igor Stravinsky's complex 12-tone serial-composed, influential master work, *Agon*. The schedule is complemented with newly commissioned & current works from renowned choreographers Adam Hougland, Alejandro Cerrudo, Caili Quan, Penny Saunders, Jermaine Spivey & Stephanie Martinez.

"Our 2022/23 season will maximize our dancers' world class skills & give audiences memorable performances worthy of the international stage," said Artistic/Executive Director Anthony Krutzkamp. "The company will showcase an immensely advanced talent pool this year with dancers hailing from Japan, France, Australia & the Philippines in addition to Sacramento's own local heroes. From Beer & Ballet, our opening in-house choreography series to leading edge works by globally recognized choreographers on through to Stravinsky & Balanchine's game-changing & still-forward-looking 'Agon,' our 2022/23 season will be one of SacBallet's most breathtaking seasons yet!"

WHEN: September 30, 2022 - May 21, 2023

Sept. 30 - Oct. 16, 2022—Beer & Ballet kicks off the season, created with the support of Sacramento's popular Bike Dog Brewery. This season opening show features new works from SacBallet's own dancer-choreographers. Included with a ticket purchase, attendees will receive one draft beer or glass of wine. Subsequent beverage purchases fundraise for SacBallet.

Dec. 10-24, 2022—SacBallet presents its treasured annual holiday celebration set to Tchaikovsky's *Nutcracker*. This year it will again feature choreography by Sacramento hometown alumni <u>Nicole Haskins</u>, <u>Colby Damon</u> & <u>Julia Feldman</u>.

Feb. 17-19, 2023— Tchaikovsky's iconic *Swan Lake* will be staged by Artistic Director Anthony Krutzkamp, who has performed the work across the US & around the world!

Mar. 31-April 2, 2023—*Visions* will showcase <u>Penny Saunders'</u> innovative *Ghost Light*, a newly commissioned work by <u>Jermaine Spivey</u> & *Extremely Close*, a mesmerizing emotionally beautiful work by <u>Alejandro Cerrudo</u>, staged with fascinating full-motion fast-moving vertical walls & dramatically lit white feathers.

May 19-21, 2023 — *Emergence* will feature Igor Stravinsky & George Balanchine's influential <u>Agon</u> plus new works by critically acclaimed choreographers <u>Caili Quan</u>, <u>Stephanie Martinez</u> & <u>Adam Hougland</u>, past Resident Choreographer at Louisville Ballet.
